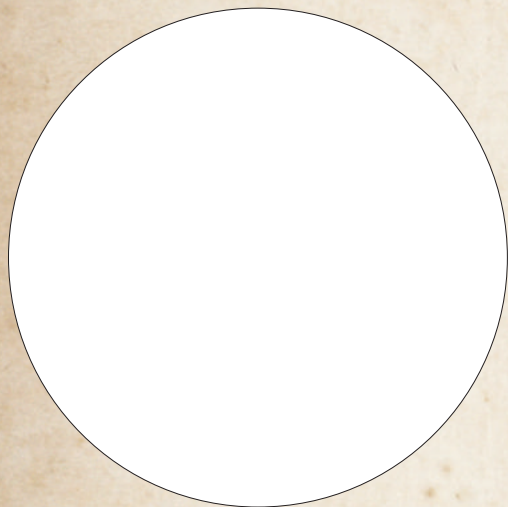
A TASTE OF HISTORY • NATHAN “NEAREST” GREEN, AFFECTIONATELY NICKNAMED UNCLE NEAREST BY HIS FRIENDS AND FAMILY IN LYNCHBURG, TENNESSEE, WAS THE FIRST AFRICAN-AMERICAN MASTER DISTILLER ON RECORD. NEAREST IS CREDITED WITH HELPING PERFECT THE GLOBALLY RECOGNIZED LINCOLN

COUNTY PROCESS, WHICH IS THE ONLY THING THAT DISTINGUISHES KENTUCKY BOURBON FROM TENNESSEE WHISKEY (OTHER THAN GEOGRAPHY). THIS UNIQUE FILTERING OF BOURBON THROUGH SUGAR MAPLE CHARCOAL WAS NAMED AFTER THE COUNTY WHERE NEAREST LIVED AND MADE WHISKEY.

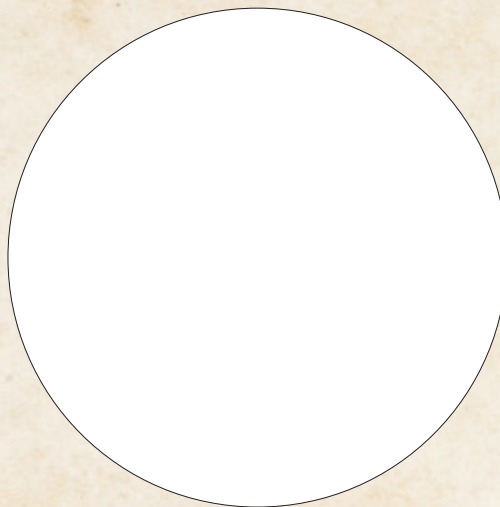

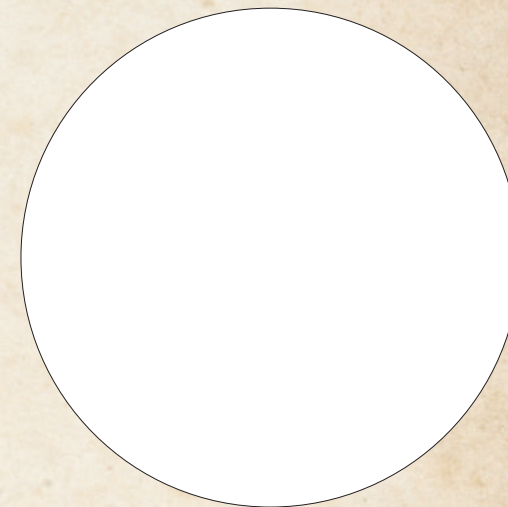

SIGNIFICANCE OF 1884: THE LAST YEAR WE BELIEVE NEAREST GREEN PUT HIS WHISKEY INTO BARRELS TO AGE.

ATTRIBUTES: A SMALL BATCH BLEND OF OUR BARRELS AT A MINIMUM OF 7-YEARS OLD, 93 PROOF, AND BARRELS ARE HAND-SELECTED BY OUR FOUNDERS, WHILE THE BATCH IS CURATED BY DESCENDANTS OF NEAREST GREEN.

NOTES: EASY SWEETNESS WITH HINTS OF CREAM, TOFFEE, VANILLA AND TOBACCO.

SIGNIFICANCE OF 1856: THIS IS THE YEAR WE BELIEVE NEAREST HELPED PERFECT THE LINCOLN COUNTY PROCESS.

ATTRIBUTES: OUR BLEND OF 8-14 YEARS OLD WHISKEYS, BOTTLED AT 100-PROOF.

NOTES: SPICY CARAMEL UP FRONT WITH THE PROOF, HINTS OF MAPLE THEN MELLOWS WITH DRIED FRUIT AND FLORAL NOTES.

SIGNIFICANCE OF 1820: IN THE 1880 CENSUS, NEAREST GREEN IS STATED TO BE 60 YEARS OLD. IF THE CENSUS IS CORRECT, HIS BIRTH YEAR WAS 1820.

ATTRIBUTES: OUR MOST RARE OFFERING. LESS THAN 1% OF OUR BARRELS WILL EVER BECOME CANDIDATES FOR THIS BOTTLE. AGED A MINIMUM OF 11 YEARS AND BOTTLED AT BARREL PROOF (ALWAYS ABOVE 108).

NOTES: EACH OF OUR BARRELS HAS A UNIQUE FLAVOR PROFILE, BUT ALL PRESENT WITH HINTS OF VANILLA, CARAMEL, AND HINTS OF VARIOUS NUTS. THIS PRODUCT HAS THE BOLDEST PALATE AND FINISH OF THE THREE.
